1908 - The Year in Brief

The first Weekly Notice was issued in Queensland on 16th June 1908 and has been issued every week thereafter, with some minor exceptions due to Public Holidays and natural disasters. The Weekly Notice was a good source of information regarding changes to signalling and safeworking throughout Queensland, and a reasonably good record exists from 1908 onwards. There were however periods when signalling and safeworking alterations were not listed in the Weekly Notice so while it is a good source of information it is not comprehensive. Other references used are newspapers and various documents held at Queensland State Archives, as well as Circular Memo's and Train Notices issued in various areas of Queensland.

By 1908 a number of signal cabins existed in Queensland, and safeworking was by Ordinary Staff and Electric Staff, there were also sections of double track existing. Listed below are the changes that occurred during 1908.
